10: ESS Earnslaw Lake Wakatipu Steamship Cruise









Step back in time when you climb aboard this 111-year-old vintage vessel. The TSS Earnslaw is the oldest commercial passenger-carrying steamship in the Southern Hemisphere and still leisurely ferries passengers from Queenstown, across Lake Whakatipu, to Walter Peak High Country Farm.

Settled by Europeans in the 1860s, Walter Peak is now a preserved rural destination, restored and open for guests to explore its beautiful shores. Admire the view of Queenstown across the bright blue lake, under mountains, and nested in forests before heading out on one of the <u>High Country Farm's many adventures</u>. Go on a guided gardens tour with an <u>Eco Experience</u> or enjoy a delicious <u>gourmet BBQ</u> at the Homestead Restaurant.

11:Skyline, Gondola & Luge Queesntown:







The Gondola in Queenstown takes visitors up 450 Meters (1,476 feet) to the top of Bobs Peak in a 5 minute ride. Its from there that you'll see the famous view of queenstown, Lake Wakatipu and The Remarkables.

The top has a restaurant and wine bar with stuinning views through glas to veiling windows.

You can also ride the luge from up here. Jump in the drivers seat in this global thrill for all ages. Nestle into the luge cart and wind you way through 1,600 meters of banked corners, tunnels and dippers.

12: Cardron Mountain Carts:



You do need to be careful on the <u>Cardrona mountain carts</u> – with all that speed you build up, you'll need to watch out for those corners! The carts at Cardrona are purpose-built in Germany, with 3 wheels, a low-to-the-ground frame, and two hydraulic disc brakes. Although they are gravity-fed, it really is an experience for adrenaline junkies! With that said, you can control your speed with the brakes. Cardrona has three mountain carting trails to choose from – so keep in mind that some trails may be closed on the day you are there. Your session runs for an awesome 2 hours and prices are from \$159 NZD for an adult and \$99 for a child.

13: AJ Hacket Bungy





Kawarau Bungy:

Height: 43 meters (141 feet)

• **Location:** Kawarau Bridge (about a 20-minute drive from town center)

Tandem Allowed: YES!Price: from \$205 NZD

• The best part: From Queenstown, you can bungy and be back in under 2 hours at this location. You are also allowed to tandem jump here or even go naked (if you're into that...)

Nevis Bungy:

• **Height:** 134 meters (440 feet)

• **Location:** Nevis River 1.5 hours from Queenstown (must take their 4wd bus to get there)

• Tandem Allowed: no

Price: \$275 NZD

• The best part: It's New Zealand's highest bungy (3rd biggest in the world with over 8 seconds of free fall!) Once you're out there, you can pair the bungy with the Nevis Swing and Catapult which are other popular Queenstown adventure experiences.

14: Parasailing Queesntown:



Parasailing in Queenstown departs from the water's edge near Earnslaw Park at Queenstown Paraflights. You can fly solo, tandem, or in a triple, making it a fun family activity. That's right, kids are allowed to go parasailing too! Parasailing is available all year round and they can guarantee you won't get wet!

At 600FT its the world's greatest parasailing flight.
